### Public Comments

- A comment from Electric City resident Jessica Dennison, was read by Mayor Kohout. The comment was addressed to the City Council Members and the Mayor with a request to ban, or severely reduce the lighting of personal fireworks within the city limits of Electric City during the upcoming 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend.

### New Business

- Fireworks
  - Chief Mark Payne, Council Members and the Mayor discussed the very dry weather conditions at this time of year and the current Electric City fireworks policy.
  - Everyone in attendance agreed that because of the very dry season and the extremely high fire danger this year the city is experiencing, that personal fireworks should be highly discouraged.
  - A motion was made and seconded to adopt Ordinance 582-2021 titled "An Ordinance Adopting a New Chapter 8.12 of the City of Electric City Municipal Code titled "Fireworks.""

- A motion was made and seconded to adopt the Mayor's Executive Order #21-01 with restricts the lighting off of personal fireworks to July 4<sup>th</sup> only, from 9am until midnight, and forbidding the lighting off of aerial fireworks entirely for the weekend of July 4<sup>th</sup> 2021.
